

RAIL ALE TRAIL RULES

Visit stations and nearby pubs, drink beer, visit local attractions, collect stickers, win a Rail Ale Trail-branded baseball cap !!

Taking part couldn't be easier! Bar staff will put one sticker on this Sticker Card when you:

1. Show them one train ticket/pass, valid for that day and time.
2. Buy a glass (half or a pint) of **CASK-CONDITIONED REAL ALE**.

Only one sticker to be collected per pub per person. Check opening hours before travelling.

There are 9 stations to be visited, each with 1 to 4 participating pubs nearby. There are 20 pubs in total, printed in **RED** on the reverse of this sheet.

Visit at least one participating pub near each station. Show them a valid train ticket/pass and buy at least one Real Ale, per person, to be given a sticker. Collect a sticker from a pub near each of the 9 stations, and one from 6 different pubs (making 15 in total) and win a Rail Ale Trail-branded baseball cap.
